Science Centre Singapore celebrates Golden Jubilee Weekend with free admission for Singapore citizens

Singapore, 30 July 2015 – In conjunction with the nation’s SG50 celebrations, Science Centre Singapore (SCS) will be providing free admission to Singapore citizens during the “Golden Jubilee Celebrations @ Science Centre Singapore”, from 7 to 10 August 2015. This free admission includes entry into six other SCS attractions - the “Human Body Experience” exhibition, the “Interplay: Where Science Meets Art” exhibition, KidsSTOP™, Snow City, The Cliff @ Snow City and the Omni-Theatre.

Singapore citizens will be required to present their National Registration Identity Cards (NRIC), valid Passports, National Service identity cards or Pioneer Generation cards at each attraction entrance to gain admission. Each card will admit the card holder and up to four children below the age of 16.

During the “Golden Jubilee Celebrations @ Science Centre Singapore”, all other visitors will be able to purchase day passes, priced at \$25 each, at the ticketing counters. These day passes will grant them entry to all SCS attractions.

Admission for all visitors would be on a ‘first-come-first-served’ basis at each attraction, subject to each attraction’s capacity. Frequent updates on admission to SCS attractions and their approximate queuing time will be made available on SCS’s Facebook page at www.facebook.com/ScienceCentreSG. Members of the public are advised to check SCS’s Facebook page on the day that they are planning to visit the Science Centre.

Associate Professor Lim Tit Meng, Chief Executive, SCS, said: “The Science Centre has inspired generations in Science, Technology, Engineering and Mathematics since 1977. As the nation celebrates its Golden Jubilee in August, the Science Centre is happy to open its doors to Singaporeans for free over the Jubilee Weekend, and to share with them the creative and experiential science learning that we bring through our various attractions and programmes.”
