 Each team has to be prepared to present a 5mins demo and be prepared to do their busking act 3 times (to perform to 3 different groups of judges)



#### **Judging Criteria**

Score	Juding Criteria	
35%	<ul> <li>Science Communication</li> <li>Explanations of demonstrations shown must be scientifically accurate, and use scientifically precise and correct language without overwhelming the audience with jargon.</li> <li>Ability to explain science concepts in everyday language without compromising on the science accuracy</li> </ul>	
35%	<ul> <li>Showmanship</li> <li>Ability to engage, interest and excite the audience</li> <li>How much 'wow' factor in the busking</li> <li>Ability to make the audience feel inspired and walk away with the feeling that they have learnt something</li> </ul>	
30%	<ul> <li>Setup, Costume, Overall look and feel</li> <li>Creative and innovative ways of showcasing demonstrations</li> <li>Blending of the look &amp; feel with the science concepts presented</li> <li>Creative booth design concepts</li> </ul>
