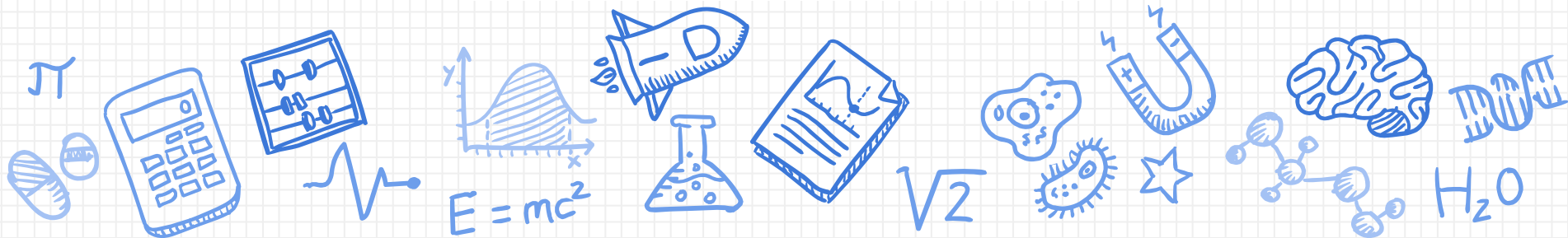

## ★ Hidden Symbols

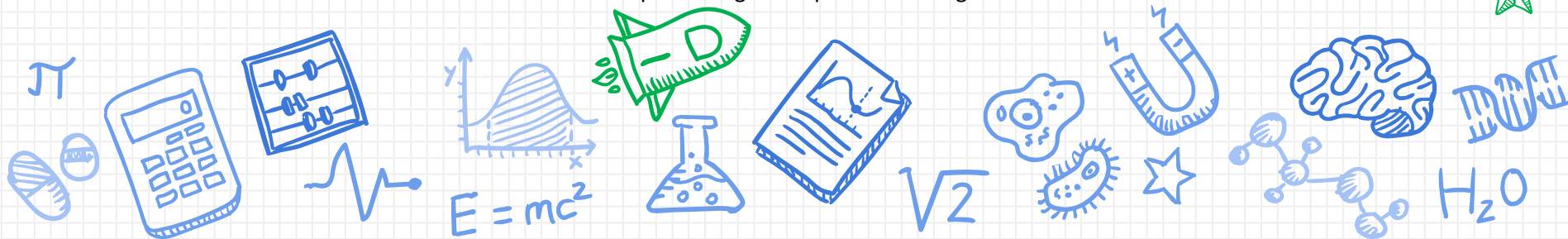
Red, Green, Blue (RGB) are the three primary colours which generate the multitude of colours, thus representing the fundamental science behind our colourful world.

The cornicle flask is a vessel in which chemicals, ingredients, matters are mixed to make compounds, thus representing mixing of ideas to create something wonderful.

The bubbles popping up vividly demonstrate the effect of a chemical reaction creating something good, thus representing the impact, message, magic, and fun of science.

The RGB motif looks like a butterfly which has been transformed through metamorphosis, thus representing the science buskers transformed from passive students into science communicator. It also implies how science learning is transformed into a life demonstration. Like a butterfly broken out of the cocoon and fly into a new phase of its life cycle, enabling reproduction of the future generation, the science buskers cross fertilise ideas and generate new and creative outcomes.

The logo also reveals two persons communicating face to face with great enthusiasm, representing the important message of 'Science is to be communicated'.

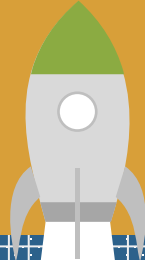


# Objectives

## Stage 3 : Audition Round

- 15, 16, 17, 20 & 21 Sept  
*via Virtual Video Conferencing*

- Two sessions each day:

- 9am – 12pm
- 2pm – 5pm

- Each team will be allocated one timeslot in one session

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- Format (to prepare for)
  - Not more than **5 min** of demonstration/presentation
  - Followed by 5 min of Q&A

- Will be informed by **4<sup>th</sup> week of September**
- Must be present for the Final Busking Round (November)
- Will be invited for a masterclass session in **1<sup>st</sup> week of October**



## Stage 5: Final Busking Round

- **Finals : 3-5 November**  
**(exact dates to be determined)**
- An onsite final round with SMM adhererd
- (will continue to monitor the situation and guidelines by MOE)
- Live judging and busking to a panel of judges
- Participants will be streamed live on the SCS social platforms
- Finalists may be invited to be featured in media interviews and press releases

### Stage 3: Audition Round

**Virtual Conferencing Auditions – 15, 16, 17, 20 & 21 September**

- Participants will be allocated a session to audition live, virtually, in front of a panel of judges
- Results release by **last week of September**
- Finalists invited to attend masterclass workshop (virtual)- **first week of October**

### Stage 4: Popularity Award

**Popularity Award (early Nov)**

- **Finalists are required to submit their science busking videos by 24 October**
- More details will be provided to finalist after being shortlisted

### Stage 5: Final Round

**Onsite Final Round – 3 to 5 November (tentative)**

SMM adhered and will continue to monitor the situation and guidelines)

- Masterclass workshop first week of October (exact dates will be provided later)
- Live judging and busking where a panel of judges and participants will perform and streamed live on SCS platforms

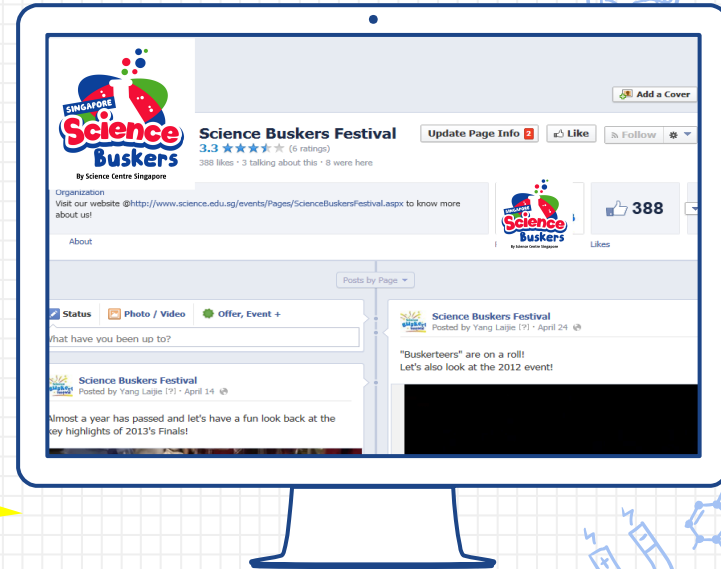


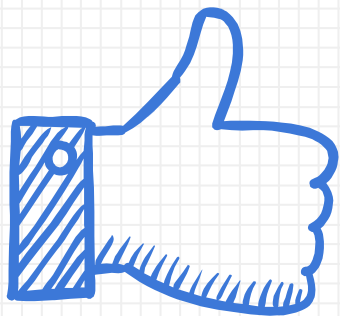
