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Singapore Science Buskers 2022 will adopt similar competition objectives as SSB 2021 and hope to continue developing each individual's communication skills through expressions of science in a creative manner.

Participants will still present and do a "show-and-tell" on any science topic. Busking and judging will be based on judges criteria and public voting.

- To raise the public awareness in the general field of science.

Stage 3 : Audition Round

18, 19, 20, 21 & 22 July via Virtual Video Conferencing

Two sessions each day:

- 9am 12pm
- 2pm 5pm



Each team will be allocated one timeslot in one session

Stage 3 : Audition Round

- Format (to prepare for)
- Not more than 5 min of demonstration/presentation
- Followed by 5 min of Q&A

A technical guide on how to set up and things to take note will be provided closer to audition dates.

Stage 3 : Audition Round

For shortlisted teams:

- Will be informed by Mid August
- Must be present for the Final Busking Round (Late Oct)
- Will be invited for a masterclass session in Late August



Stage 4 : People's Choice Awards

- Period : October 2022
- Online Voting format
- Finalists are required to submit their science busking video by Mid Sept
- Details will be provided to finalists on a later date



Stage 5: Final Busking Round

- Finals : Late Oct (exact date to be determined)
- An onsite final round with SMM adhererd (will continue to monitor the situation and guidelines by MOE)
- Live judging and busking to a panel of judges

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Judging Criteria

Score	Juding Criteria	
35%	 Science Communication Explanations of demonstrations shown must be scientifically accurate, and use scientifically precise and correct language without overwhelming the audience with jargon. Ability to explain science concepts in everyday language without compromising on the science accuracy 	
35%	 Showmanship Ability to engage, interest and excite the audience Ability to express the 'wow' factor in the busking Ability to make the audience feel inspired and walk away with the feeling that they have learnt something 	
30%	 Setup, Costume, Overall look and feel Creative and innovative ways of showcasing demonstrations Blending of the look & feel with the science concepts presented Creative booth design concepts

A maximum concentration of 3% for Hydrogen Peroxide is allowed. It is dangerous for students to handle more than that.






NO open flame or flammable gases


