Winners of the WhizKid (P3 – 6) category each received a certificate on top of the following prizes respectively (the prize is shared between the two members for team entries). The Best Creation awards were also given to three students who excelled in the toy-making challenge during the Final Judging: The Challenge at the Final Judging Round was for the students to construct a vehicle that will transport a person to travel “safely” the longest distance from the top of a ramp.’ The toys the students made would be released from the top of a ramp and the distance measured would start from the bottom-end of the ramp. The ramp will be provided.

Blue Ribbon & Diamond Awards

There were 23 Blue Ribbon recipients and each were given a certificate. 8 Diamond Award recipients received a certificate and a trophy to recognise their contributions.

Currently, the criteria for SCSA Blue Ribbon Award are:

- Teacher was instrumental in organising the SCSA (Schools) Competition.
- The award is NOT restricted to science teachers or HOD science. All teachers who had played a part in organising the SCSA (Schools) Competition are eligible.
- Not applicable to School Support Staff (eg. Allied Educators, lab technicians, technical staff, etc)
- One school is allowed to nominate maximum of three teachers for each award.
- the influence teachers have on their students in the SCSA (Schools) Competition;
- the role of teachers in motivating their students;
- the role teachers play in guiding, mentoring, and advising students

The criteria for the SCSA Diamond Award are:

- Received at least two Blue Ribbon Awards prior.
- Recipients will only be eligible to receive the Diamond Award once based on his/her two sets (or more) of Blue Ribbon Awards. Another Diamond Award is given based on the next set of Blue Ribbon awards.
- have been involved in SCSA for at least 3 years and active for the last 2 consecutive years (eg. applied for Diamond Award in 2018, must be active in 2017 and 2018, and one other year);
- emphasizes awareness and participation of students in the SCSA competition; and
- displayed a track record of improving students' achievements, using innovative out-of-classroom programme/activity.
- demonstrate mentorship of another 'Blue Ribbon' recipient
