

The Snail






Head out to a grassy area during a rainy day and look out for snails.

Their shells are conical in shape, large at the bottom and narrow at the top.


In order to keep their large shells strong and healthy, these snails have to eat a lot.

Some types of snails are edible and they are considered to be a delicacy in some countries.




