Picnic Under the Planets Frequently Asked Questions

1. What is Picnic Under the Planets?

Jointly organised by Science Centre Singapore and the Smithsonian Channel, in partnership with Blue Ant Media and StarHub, Picnic Under the Planets is an after-hours event to commemorate the moon landing's 50th anniversary. Held at the Lakeside Lawn at Science Centre Singapore from 6pm to 11.30pm, this outdoor event will feature activities such as movie screenings, a Super Cool Science Show, digital planetarium shows and stargazing sessions* and fringe activities.

Science Centre Singapore will be screening two movies, which will be chosen by our Facebook fans during two separate social media polls. Find out more about the social media polls on www.facebook.com/ScienceCentreSG.

In our effort to celebrate this monumental event, Science Centre Singapore will also be launching the "Moonshot 50" exhibition, which will showcase "To the Moon: Snoopy Soars with NASA" travelling exhibition.

2. What is the admission rate to Picnic Under the Planets?

All guests can enjoy complimentary admission to Picnic Under the Planets.

**Kindly note that Science Centre Singapore general admission rates apply to "Moonshot 50" and "To the Moon: Snoopy Soars with NASA" exhibitions. However, the Centre will be offering ala-carte admission rates to both exhibitions on 20 July 2019 from 4pm onwards. Please refer to the table below for more details on the ala-carte rates:*

3. Do I have to register for Picnic Under the Planets?

No registration is required to enter Picnic Under the Planets.

Kindly note that the queue line for Picnic Under the Planets movie screenings will start at the Snow City carpark.

However, please register for the stargazing sessions beforehand at www.scob.eventbrite.com. The sign-up sheet will be made available from 7am from 20 July 2019.

Admission to all activities at Picnic Under the Planets is strictly based on a queue system (first-come-first-served basis) and is subject to the available capacity at any given time. We seek your kind understanding and co-operation with regards to the event significant waiting times and queue lines.

4. Is re-entry permitted?

Public can re-enter the picnic grounds. To ensure fairness, no reservation of queue places will be permitted.

9. Can we take photographs or video recordings?

Guests may take photographs and video recordings at all locations with the exception of Omni-Theatre.

Please note that Science Centre Singapore will also be taking photographs and video recordings of our visitors during the event for any purpose, without prior approval or compensation.

10. Are we allowed to bring pets?

Pets are not allowed.

11. Where should I go for first aid treatment?

You can approach any of our friendly staff or our Visitor Services Assistant who will be able to render assistance for first aid.

The First Aid Room is located at KidsSTOP™ (near Lijiang Restaurant) while the AED device is located at KidsSTOP™ Lobby.

12. How do I get to Science Centre Directions to Science Centre Singapore?

By Bus:

Buses 66, 178, 198 and 335 stop right outside Science Centre Singapore. Other buses serving nearby bus stops include 51, 52, 78, 79, 97, 97e, 98, 98M, 105, 143, 160, 176, 183, 197, 333, 334, 506, 542, and 543. Please refer to the map for details.

By MRT Train:

The nearest MRT station is Jurong East Station, which is on both the East-West Line and the North-South Line. Proceed to the bus interchange to board bus 66 or 335. Alternatively, you may take a short walk to Science Centre Singapore.

Walking from Jurong East Interchange:

Science Centre Singapore is just an 8-minute walk from Jurong East Bus Interchange/MRT Station:

- Walk at the covered walkway from the interchange towards Jurong East St 13.
- Cross the street and continue in the same direction along Block 135.
- Keep going in the same direction until you reach a road intersection.
- The building located diagonally across that intersection is Science Centre Singapore.



13. Where can I park my cars?

Guests are encouraged to take the public transport as there is limited carpark space within the premises of Science Centre Singapore and KidsSTOP™. Kindly note that certain parts of the KidsSTOP™ carpark will be cordoned-off for safety purposes. The charges are as follows:

**The above grace period is given to vehicles to help facilitate any passenger(s) drop-offs and delivery of goods for your events and activities. Please note that vehicles exceeding this grace period will be charged for parking accordingly.*

CashCard Top-up Machine

We do not have a CashCard top-up machine onsite. However, you may top up your CashCard at the POSB ATM located just around the corner of Curiosity Shop in Science Centre Singapore.
